

Directions from the airport to the training location TechGate and the recommended Hotel Arcotel Kaiserwasser

Vienna Airport Lines (airport bus):

Bus to station Kaiserermühlen VIC (Vienna International Center), approx. 30 min travel time

City Airport Transport (CAT) + public transport:

Nonstop 16 minutes train ride into the city centre of Vienna to station “Wien Landstraße”.

Continue with the metro U4 (direction “Heiligenstadt”) until “Schwedenplatz”. Change onto metro U1 (direction Leopoldau) until “Kaiserermühlen V.I.C.”.

TRANSPORTATION IN VIENNA

Public Transport

You can buy tickets directly inside the bus/tram (but NOT in trains!), at selling points at the various stations or online through a mobile app (Qando).

As you might need a ticket for the transfer to and from the hotel as well as for getting around if you find the time, it is recommended to purchase a day ticket.

Taxi:

To go by taxi will be the most convenient and fastest way to get from the airport to the hotel and therefore also the most expensive one – it will cost approx. 30 EUR one way. About Vienna

Vienna, the capital of Austria with its 1.7 Mio. inhabitants is located in the heart of Europe. With the **Bureau of the United Nations** in Vienna the city is one of the four official residences of the **United Nations**. The city with its historical and cultural highlights as well as the Viennese hospitality attracts millions of tourists every year.

A couple of centuries ago **Vienna** was the **residence of the Habsburg dynasty** and since that time Vienna has a great diversity of magnificent historical buildings, churches and parks. **Schönbrunn**, the summer residence of the former monarchs is now one of the highlights of **Vienna** with a beautiful palace, great gardens and wonderful surroundings. More than 5 million people visit Schönbrunn every year. **1996 Schönbrunn Palace** became UNESCO World Cultural Heritage as one of the most important cultural monuments in Austria.

The Viennese **St. Stephen´s Cathedrale** (in German Stephansdom) is the most famous gothic building of Austria and the seat of the Archbishop of Vienna.

With the **Giant Ferris Wheel**, one of the city´s landmarks, with its famous technical structure people have a unique view across the **Prater** and Vienna.

Vienna is also called the capital city of music because of its numerous celebrated classic musicians like **Schubert, Mozart** or **Mahler**. Also culture and art like fine arts, theatres or the Vienna Opera have a very long tradition.

The **Wiener Schnitzel** and the **Sachertorte** are typical Viennese specialities. Viennese cafes and restaurants are famous for their cosiness and excellent kitchen.

The **Donauinsel** and the **Alte Donau** invite to long walks, bicycle tours and pleasant evenings in typical Viennese taverns.

Vienna is one of the most romantic and beautiful places in the Europe and invites you to discover its history and culture.
